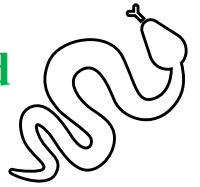




Four Days Workshop on Wildlife Conservation and Awareness-2023

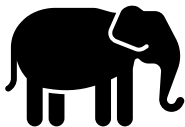
